When setting up automatic package downloads with Aspera on Cloud, users only see the first 50 workspaces instead of all available workspaces.	Aspera/connect-app#1155

Server Requirements

One of the following:

- IBM Aspera Shares - a currently supported version
- IBM Aspera Faspex - a currently supported version
- IBM Aspera High-Speed Transfer Server (HSTS) - 3.9.6 or higher recommended

To use Connect's Aspera Drive synchronization features, the server must have a Sync-enabled license.

The minimum version of Connect that works with the Connect SDK is 3.9.0.

<p>[macOS] The current one-click installer does not support a system-wide install on macOS. Workaround: To do a system-wide install on macOS with the current one-click installer:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Log in as an Administrator of the machine.2. Open the binary distribution file (.dmg file) to mount the installer3. Run: <pre>sudo /Volumes/ibm-aspera-connect_4.1xx_macOS_x86_64/IBM\ Aspera\ Connect\ Installer.app/Contents/Resources/install true</pre>	Aspera/connect-app#901
<p>Windows Explorer crashes in some situations trying to view package files in Faspex 5 BETA.</p> <p>Note: This issue will be resolved in future updates to Faspex 5 BETA.</p>	Aspera/connect-app#811
