ISSUES FIXED IN THIS RELEASE

Core#639 - asperatrapd may fail to authenticate when using assumed roles in EC2 to authenticate with S3 storage.

This patch needs to be installed on top of an existing HSTS 4.4.1 install. Run the following commands as root or with sudo to apply the patch:

```
$ cp -f /opt/aspera/lib/java/trapd/aspera-transfer-proxy.jar /opt/aspera/lib/java/trapd/aspera-
transfer-proxy.jar_4.4.1_backup
$ tar xvf aspera-transfer-proxy.tar.gz -C /opt/aspera/lib/java/trapd/
$ systemctl restart asperatrapd
```
