PATCH INSTRUCTIONS

Applying the patch for Linux systems:

1. Download the patch file (`IBM_Aspira_Shares_1.10.0_Linux_Windows_Patch_Level_1.zip`) and unzip it.
2. Make sure to back-up all the files in the shares folder (`/opt/aspera/shares/`).
3. Stop the Shares service:

```
service aspera-shares stop
```

4. Run the following command to replace existing files with patch files:

Important: The file path "`<path/to/patch/folder>/IBM_Aspira_Shares_1.10.0_Linux_Windows_Patch_Level_1`" is the equivalent of `<patch_path>` in the command.

```
/bin/cp -r <patch_path>* /opt/aspera/shares/u/shares/
```

5. Run the following command to remove the previous version of JQuery-UI (**Optional**):

```
rm -rf /opt/aspera/shares/u/shares/public/javascripts/third-party/jquery-ui-1.12.1
```

6. Restart the Shares service:

```
service aspera-shares restart
```

7. Check the patch level number listed in the footer to confirm the patch was installed correctly. (beneath the version number).

Applying the patch for Windows systems:

1. Download the patch file (`IBM_Aspira_Shares_1.10.0_Linux_Windows_Patch_Level_1.zip`) and unzip it.

2. Make sure to back up all the files in the shares folder (C:\Shares).
3. Stop all Shares services with patch files:
 - a. Go to **Control Panel > Administrative Tools > Services**.
 - b. Right click each 'IBM Aspera Shares' services and select **Stop** from the menu.
4. Copy the patch files to the corresponding directories under C:\Shares\www to replace the existing files.
5. Remove the previous version of JQuery-UI: (C:\Shares\www\public\javascripts\third-party\jquery-ui-1.12.1)(**Optional**)
6. Restart all Shares services:
 - a. Go to **Control Panel > Administrative Tools > Services**.
 - b. Right click each 'IBM Aspera Shares' service and select **Start** from the menu.
7. Check the patch level number listed in the footer to confirm the patch was installed correctly. (beneath the version number).
