Description

The remote support system for the IBM System Storage requires TCP/IP communication between the XIV® system and the XIV Remote Support Center. When an XIV system does not have direct access to the Internet (for example, due to a firewall), you can use the IBM XIV Remote Support Proxy to facilitate that connection.

The following list provides the current technical changes and enhancements to the Remote Support Proxy:

• After Remote Support Proxy v1.3.0 runs for a period of time, it stops allowing new connections between XIV systems and the XIV Remote Support Center. Remote Support Proxy v1.3.1 fixes this issue.

System requirements

The following operating systems are supported:

- Red Hat Enterprise Linux, version 6.0 or later, for x86 and x86-64 systems
- Red Hat Enterprise Linux, version 5.1 or later, for x86 and x86-64 systems
- Red Hat Enterprise Linux, version 4.6 or later, for x86 and x86-64 systems
- SUSE Linux Enterprise Server 11 or later, for x86 and x86-64 systems
